### Objective and Design:

- Provide tuition assistance to underserved students who wish to attend Catholic high schools within the City of St. Louis and North St. Louis County.
- Enhance the sustainability of the designated schools and stimulate workforce and economic development for the greater St. Louis region.

### Guidelines:

- Maximum award amount is \$4,000 per student per school year.
- Family is responsible for all fees and remaining tuition.
- All applicants will be considered solely on the basis of financial need, regardless of their affiliation with any faith tradition.
- Awards will be granted to new and existing students, subject to funding availability.
- Awards renew through graduation, upon annual income requalification.
- Awards are transferrable to other SOAR!-eligible high schools.
- Families with multiple children can receive more than one SOAR! Scholarship.
- Scholarships may be awarded at the following schools, subject to funding availability at each school:
