- A **\$6,375 annual scholarship** for eligible K-12 students
- **Renewable** through high school
- No family tax liability
- Unused **funds rollover** to support future tuition obligations thru high school (grade 12)
- Access to exceptional private education and approved educational resources

Who is Eligible?

Students must live in St. Louis City, Saint Louis County, St. Charles County or Jefferson County to qualify.

IEP/ISP

- Private School
- Not intended for students remaining in public schools

100% Free & Reduced Lunch

Must have attended a public or charter public school for one semester within the year prior to applying

OR

Entering Kindergarten or 1st grade
